

## Recommended trees for planting from Wakefield Nursery Management

If I were a homeowner and was looking for a great specimen tree to plant I would use the following:

1. Instead of Bradford Pear, Cleveland Select Pear which is much more hardy as far as wind and hardness of wood.
2. Instead of Leyland Cypress, Green Giant Arborvitae; great tree less insect disease problems.
3. Weeping Willow Tree, Ailee Elm; great tree if trying to accomplish shade grows more upright.
4. Others, Golden Rain Tree, Zelkova, Pistachio, Eastern Redbud, Dogwoods are great trees that do not grow quiet as fast and will take much longer to reach maturity.
