Recommended trees for planting from Wakefield Nursery Management

If I were a homeowner and was looking for a great specimen tree to plant I would use the following:

- 1. Instead of Bradford Pear, Cleveland Select Pear which is much more hardy as far as wind and hardness of wood.
- 2. Instead of Leyland Cypress, Green Giant Arborvitae; great tree less insect disease problems.
- 3. Weeping Willow Tree, Ailee Elm; great tree if trying to accomplish shade grows more upright.
- 4. Others, Golden Rain Tree, Zelkova, Pistachio, Eastern Redbud, Dogwoods are great trees that do not grow quiet as fast and will take much longer to reach maturity.
